**UA THEATRE & DANCE RETURNS WITH *ALABAMA REPERTORY DANCE

The University of Alabama Department of Theatre and Dance begins the second half of its 2014-2015 season with *Alabama Repertory Dance Theatre (ARDT)* in Morgan Auditorium.

*ARDT* features multiple dance pieces of various styles, choreographed by UA faculty. Two of the pieces highlighted are from UA Theatre & Dance's newest faculty members, Lawrence Jackson and Rebecca Salzer. Jackson's "Continuum" is an up-tempo, modern piece with jazz undertones. Jackson stated, "The piece speaks to the pattern of life. As we enter our time here on Earth, we keep coming back to the same experiences. Hopefully, through wisdom, we learn how to deal with those situations differently. "

Salzer's "Interstellar Responses" is an excerpt from a longer piece in collaboration with UA Department of Music's, Dr. Amir Zaher based on James D. Stein's book, *Cosmic Numbers: The Numbers That Define Our Universe*.

*ARDT* runs Tuesday, February 10 to Thursday, November 13 at 7:30pm, Friday, February 13 at 5:30pm, and Saturday, February 14 at 2:00pm.
